1.	Who we are?	Twenty Twenty Productions Limited (Company Reg No: 03231683) whose postal address is 85 Gray’s Inn Road London WC1X 8TX (“ we ”, “ us ”, “ our ”) are the production company and the data controller for the purposes of casting, development, production and/or distribution of “All That Glitters” (working title) (the “ Programme ”) and/or as otherwise agreed between us.
2.	Personal Data	As the data controller, we are the organisation who collects, handles, uses, stores and/or processes (together “ Process ”) any personal data and/or sensitive personal data (together “ Data ”) you may share with us and/or that we may receive about you. 3.	About the Programme	a) These application terms and conditions (“ Terms and Conditions ”) relate to your application to take part in the talent search within the Programme (including any re-edited, re-voiced, reformatted, updated or compilation or any other versions thereof or further series or spin-offs) and/or other content. b) “All That Glitters” is a brand new talent search to find Britain’s most brilliant jeweller. It is produced by us for BBC Two (the “ Broadcaster ”). Unfolding inside a specially built workshop, this six-part contest is built on the extraordinary skills of eight talented jewellers from all walks of life. Each week, the jewellers battle it out to make real clients’ dreams come true, transforming emotion into objects of beauty that last forever. The challenges will explore the wildly different styles and aesthetics that can be found across different types of jewellery and some will even be inspired by the world’s most famous and coveted pieces. Every episode is bursting with science, history, and culture: from molecular structures to ancient Egyptians to red carpet styles. Eight jewellers will enter the workshop...but only one can prove they are a cut above the rest and claim the ‘ All That Glitters ’ crown.
4.	Purpose of these Terms and Conditions	a) These Terms and Conditions apply to all individuals who apply and/or otherwise indicate to us that they wish to be considered to take part in the Programme (“ apply/ing ”) which we propose but do not undertake to produce. b) By applying to take part in the Programme, whether by submitting an application form to us or otherwise, you confirm that you agree to and shall comply with these Terms and Conditions. c) For the purposes of these Terms and Conditions, “ Application Date ” shall mean the date on which you apply to take part in the Programme,

5.	Eligibility Requirements	<p>a) All individuals applying to take part in the Programme MUST:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> i) be aged 18 years or over as of the Application Date; ii) be living in the UK as a legal resident; iii) not be or have not ever been employed by us and/or the Broadcaster; and iv) make yourself available for the purposes of the Programme and attend such meetings, rehearsals, performances and/or otherwise as required by us during the production of the Programme <p>(collectively, the “Eligibility Requirements”).</p> <p>b) By submitting your application to take part in the Programme, whether by completing and returning an application form to us or otherwise, you confirm and agree that you comply with all the Eligibility Requirements.</p> <p>c) You undertake to inform us should you become aware that you do not comply or for some reason have ceased to comply with the Eligibility Requirements.</p>
6.	Background Checks and Information Gathering	<p>a) You acknowledge and agree that we may undertake background checks as part of the casting process. You agree to provide (or assist us in obtaining) further information, documentation, references and/or evidence as requested by us for the purpose of verifying that you comply with the Eligibility Requirements and undertaking background checks.</p> <p>b) Participation in the Programme will be subject to all necessary paperwork, background checks, references and/or consents as requested by us being promptly completed and returned to us (which may include without limitation information regarding your health and/or criminal and/or civil actions and/or convictions).</p> <p>c) If you or any member of your immediate family and/or household are currently or in the past twelve months have been an employee, contractor, officer, director or agent of us, Warner Bros. International Television Production Group, or anyone connected with the Programme, you agree to notify us whether on your application form or otherwise.</p>
7.	Casting and Selection and Production Process	<p>a) We shall have the right to research, scout and make enquiries to find and/or encourage those who are eligible to take part in the Programme, to apply and/or audition as a contributor.</p> <p>b) We reserve the right to refuse any submitted application. There will be no right of appeal against any decisions taken by us on this or any matter relating to the casting, selection and/or production of the Programme. Unfortunately, due to the large number of applications we receive, we will only contact you if you are successful in being selected as a potential contributor for the Programme.</p> <p>c) You accept that submission of an application form, compliance with these Terms and Conditions, receiving a phone call from a member of the production team, attending an audition and/or attending any recording days DOES NOT constitute an offer to appear in or automatically mean you will be appearing in the Programme.</p> <p>d) We reserve the right, at our sole discretion, to stand you down and/or choose not to film with you during the casting, selection and/or</p>

		<p>production process, even if you have been given a date to attend auditions and/or have been filmed for the Programme.</p> <p>e) You understand that we reserve the right to vary any element of the Programme and, even if you meet the Eligibility Requirements outlined above, we shall have no obligation to produce any episode of the Programme, to broadcast any episode of the Programme, or to select you as a contributor, and even if you are selected we are not obliged to include your Contribution (as defined below) in the Programme.</p> <p>f) The chosen contributors will be required to undertake such duties and/or obligations and/or sign such documentation granting all necessary rights as notified to them by us, including without limitation entering into a contributor's agreement and providing passport details, and shall do so promptly.</p> <p>g) We will notify each contributor of the date, times and locations of any and all filming and failure to attend such date, time and location may result in the contributor being withdrawn.</p>
<p>8.</p>	<p>Your Obligations</p>	<p>a) You agree that you will not withhold from us any material fact that may in our reasonable opinion jeopardise or otherwise impact on the Programme or which might result in publicity adverse to our good name and/or the Programme.</p> <p>b) You confirm to us that:</p> <p>i) any information you provide to us, whether in the application form or otherwise, is truthful, complete, accurate and not misleading and you have not deceived or attempted to mislead us in any way (including but not limited to in your identity and/or health);</p> <p>ii) by reason of your conduct (including past conduct) you shall not bring us into disrepute;</p> <p>iii) you agree to comply with and adhere to these Terms and Conditions;</p> <p>iv) you will notify us in the event any Data we Process about you is incorrect and/or requires updating, changing and/or correcting. Please refer to our Privacy Policy https://www.twentytwenty.tv/TV_Production_Privacy.aspx which provides the relevant contact details.</p> <p>c) If you are found to have knowingly supplied inaccurate, misleading or false information to us, you acknowledge and agree that you may be immediately disqualified from the casting process and/or taking part in the Programme.</p>
<p>9.</p>	<p>Intellectual Property Rights</p>	<p>a) If you are invited to attend subsequent filmed stages of the audition, selection and/or production process for the Programme and in consideration of us arranging to film you (and other good and valuable consideration sufficiency of which is acknowledged by you), you agree to the photographing, recording and filming of your interview, contribution and/or performance during and in connection with the Programme ("Contribution") and the use of your Contribution (or any part(s) thereof) in the Programme.</p> <p>b) You grant to us all necessary rights and consents to permit us to make the fullest use of the Contribution and/or any information,</p>

		<p>photographic/video material submitted by you as part of your application for and/or participation in the Programme (collectively referred to as the "Material(s)") for any purposes connected with the promotion and exploitation of the Programme, and/or ancillary products, rights, services and/or in connection with us, in any and all media now known or hereafter invented throughout the world in perpetuity.</p> <p>c) You accept that we have the right to edit, copy, adapt and/or translate the Material(s) and/or Contribution as we see fit and you irrevocably waive the benefits of and agree not to assert any provision of law known as "moral rights" or any similar laws of any jurisdiction.</p> <p>d) You agree that we have no obligation whatsoever to return any Material(s) whether or not you are selected as a contributor for the Programme and that we are in no way obligated to use any of the Material(s) in connection with the Programme.</p> <p>e) You grant us the right to use your name, voice, likeness, photographs and any biographical material concerning you in the Programme and in connection with the casting, development, production, publicity promotion and exploitation of the Programme and/or ancillary products, services and/or rights and/or in connection with us, throughout the world in all media in perpetuity.</p>
10.	Confidentiality	<p>You will keep strictly confidential and will not without our prior written consent at any time publish or disclose to any person (including without limitation via the internet or any social networking sites such as Instagram, Facebook and/or Twitter) any conversation, information or photographs concerning the Programme and/or the application, selection, filming and/or production process which comes to your knowledge nor other information relating to us, or the Programme acquired by you, other than information already in the public domain.</p>
11.	General	<p>a) The rights granted under these Terms and Conditions are freely assignable and licensable by us.</p> <p>b) Any trademarks, logos, graphics, photographs, videos and texts featured on the Programme Casting website and/or in the Programme remain our intellectual property and may not be reproduced, used or represented without our express prior permission.</p> <p>c) You acknowledge and agree that neither us nor our assignees and/or licensees shall be liable for any loss, damage, injury, claim and/or disappointment suffered, by you (including but not limited to special or consequential loss, loss of reputation, trespass to property or trespass to person) in connection with your involvement in the Programme, other than death or personal injury caused by our negligence or other liability that is prohibited from being limited or excluded by law.</p> <p>d) You agree that you shall not be entitled to injunct or restrain the transmission of the Programme or the use of the Contribution and/or Material(s) and/or any programmes and/or ancillary use which includes the Contribution and/or Material(s) (or any part of it).</p> <p>e) Failure by us to take action in respect of the breach by you of any provisions of these Terms and Conditions shall not be interpreted as constituting a waiver by us of the right to take action in future in respect of such a breach.</p> <p>f) We reserve the right, in our sole discretion, to change, amend, withdraw,</p>
